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As a SDP teacher, I am writing to provide written testimony about online instruction. If full or a hybrid model on on-line instruction is going to occur next year, SDP needs to work closely with PFT to create clear criteria and job expectations. As part of this, one thing I think SDP should insist on is that teachers be required to hold "virtual check-in meetings" with families. These can be conducted on-line, by phone call, or by text, but the must occur at regular and on-going intervals for our students to succeed. Frankly, it broke my heart that some teachers bemoaned their students' lack of participation in on-line learning; yet, they also never reached out to families to assess barriers and challenges. This is inexcusable, and in my opinion, it means that we have failed to teach our students. A calendar of when these meetings should occur needs be created, and if we are teaching on-line, following this calendar should be part of our REQUIRED professional expectations and responsibilities.

And, as an SDP parent, I am gong to be brief: do not approve any non-essential expenses at this time. This includes spending and/or external contracts for professional development, wellness, and some of the other items I am seeing on this agenda. Please do not approve these expenses. We do not know what next year will bring, and all district funds need saved for the "unexpected".
