Why In-Person Learning Matters in Philadelphia

- **Children**, especially young learners and those with complex needs, **learn best in a classroom** with a great teacher.
- At school, children learn vital **social, emotional, and behavioral skills**.
- Lack of in-person learning options **disproportionately harms** low-income and minority children.

The Plan: Phasing in Groups of Students

Students will phase into hybrid learning starting with PreK - 2. Other student groups will continue to phase in as long as it is safe to do so.

Phase	Student Group	Timing <i>(As long as conditions support it is safe to proceed)</i>
1	All PreK - 2 students	November 30, 2020
2	Students with complex needs in grades 3-12	TBD - Ideally January
3	9th grade students and CTE students	TBD - Ideally late Jan/early Feb
4+	Order and timing for remaining student groups TBD based on conditions	

The Selection Process

Families will be able to choose whether they want their child to transition to hybrid learning OR continue with 100% digital learning.

- **For Phase 1 - PreK - 2 families:**

- Building awareness and understanding of options: Oct. 14 - 26
- Selection window: Oct. 26 - 30

- **Making a Selection:**

- **By Electronic Form** - Parents will receive an email for each child they have in PreK - 2 prompting them to make a selection
- **By Phone** - Parents can call their child's school and make a selection

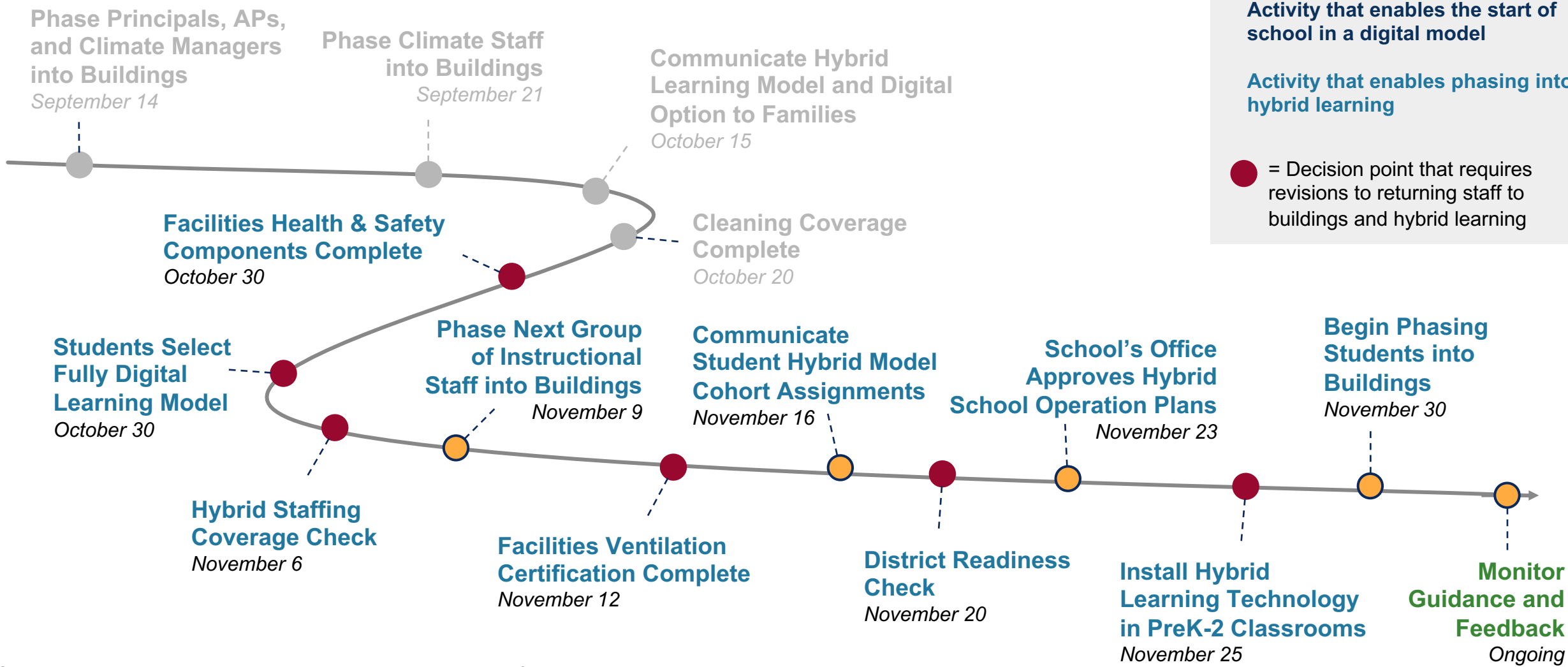
Hybrid Learning Model

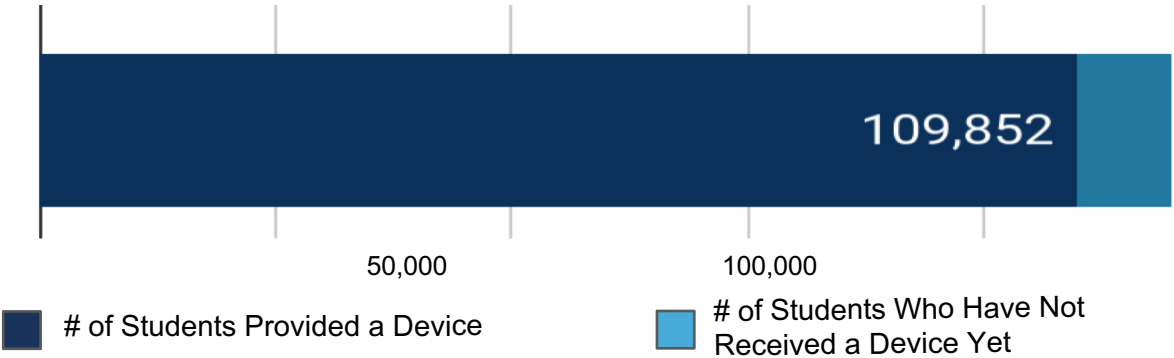

 - Development of a reconnecting tool kit for families

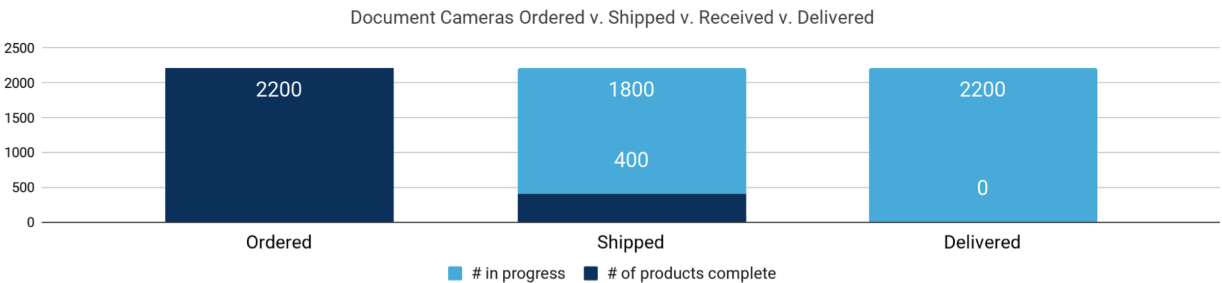
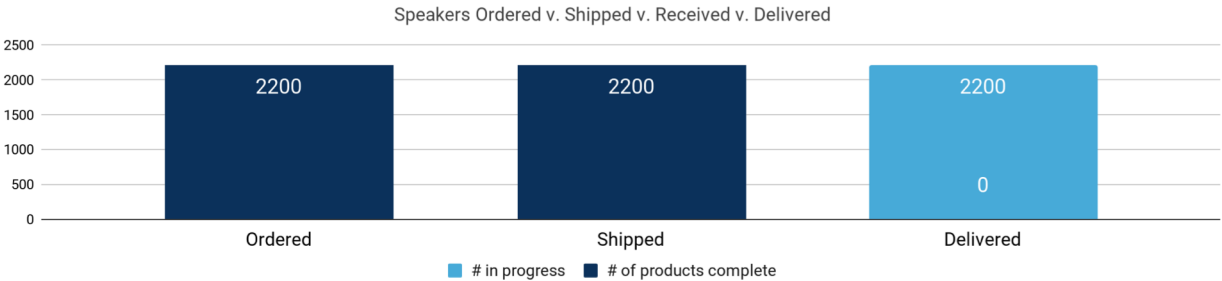

 - Creating and deploying building subs

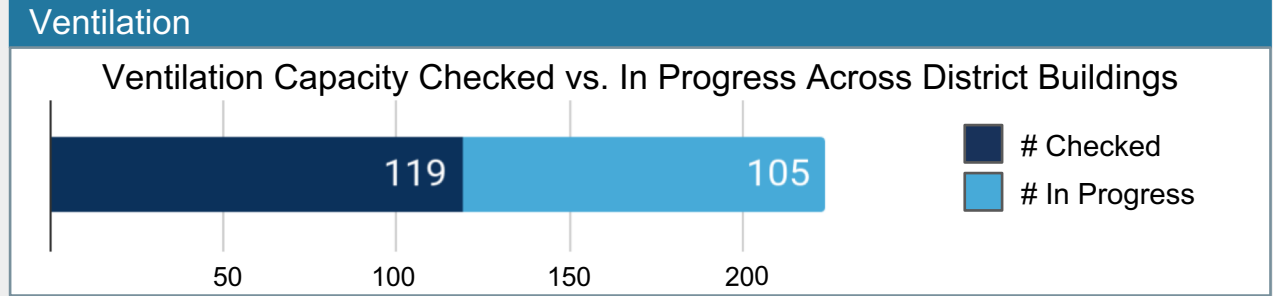
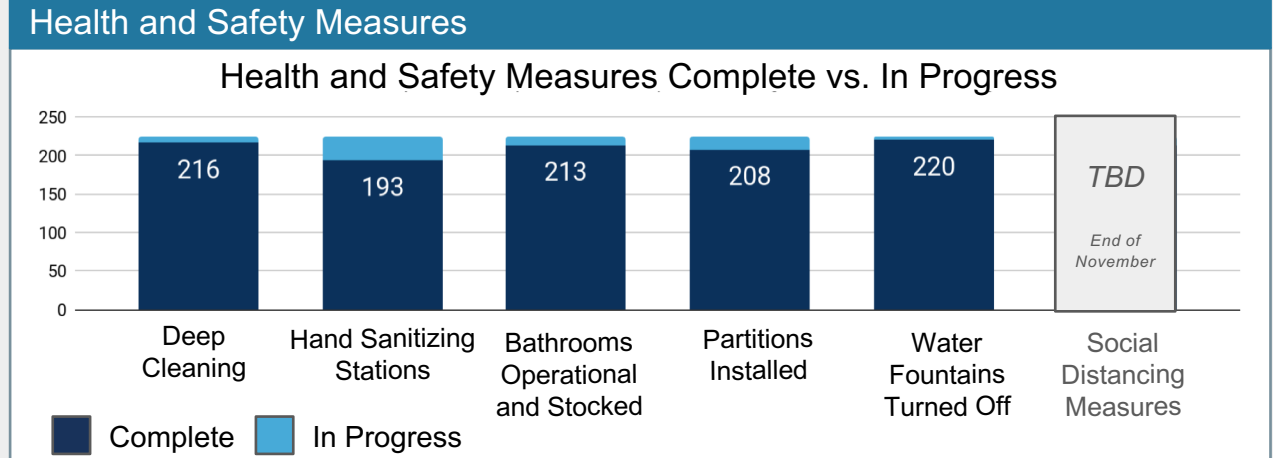
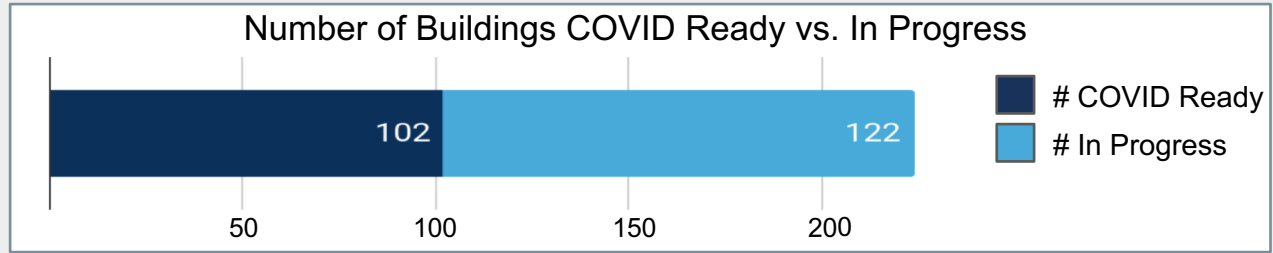
