# 137.1 EXTRACURRICULAR **AND CO-CURRICULAR** PARTICIPATION BY HOME EDUCATION STUDENTS

### **Purpose**

The Board of Education ("Board") is committed to every student receiving a well rounded education and graduating ready for college and careers. This Policy's purpose is to require the School District of Philadelphia ("District") to provide access to co-curricular and extracurricular educational activities for eligible students participating in home education programs in accordance with relevant state and federal laws.

#### **Authority**

The Pennsylvania Public School Code and Federal Law requires that students enrolled in a home education program shall be permitted to participate in various District activities. [1][2][check if additional cites necessary]

#### **Definitions**

The School Reform CommissionBoard shall approve participation in the district's extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs by a Eligible Student Participating in a Home Education Program: A student enrolled in a home education program subject to the following conditions:[1][2]

- 1. The student shall be a resident of the school district.
- 2. The student shall meet the required eligibility criteria. [3][4]
- 3. The student shall maintain appropriate insurance coverage, consistent with the coverage requirements for district students.[4]

- 4. The student shall comply with <del>SRC</del>Board policies and school rules and regulations regarding co-curricular and extracurricular activities, interscholastic athletics, and student discipline, as well as the organization governing the activity.[3][4][5]
- 5. The student shall comply with policies, rules and regulations, or their equivalent, of the activity's governing organization.
- 6. The student shall meet attendance and reporting requirements established for all participants of the activity or program: and to be considered in attendance in accordance with Board policy, the home education student must participate in a full, normally scheduled academic program, in accordance with the planned home education program and submitted documentation.[2][6]
- 7. The student shall meet the requirements for physical examinations and physical fitness and any height and/or weight restrictions established for all participants of the activity or program.[4]
- 8. The student shall comply with all requirements and directives of the dDistrict staff, coaches and administrators involved with the co-curricular and extracurricular activity or interscholastic athletic program.

The SRC shall not provide individual transportation for students enrolled in home education programs who participate in the district's extracurricular activities or interscholastic athletic programs. When the district provides transportation to and from an away competition, game, event or exhibition and requires district students to use district transportation, home education students shall be required to use the transportation provided by the district.

#### **Delegation of Responsibility**

The Superintendent or their designee, through the Deputy Superintendent of Academic Services, shall develop Administrative Procedures that at a minimum provide resources for eligible home education students and their program supervisors regarding the District's extracurricular activities, co-curricular, and interscholastic athletic programs. The Deputy Superintendent of Academic Services, in coordination with the Office of Transportation Services, shall include information about transportation of eligible home education students to co-curricular and extracurricular activities, and interscholastic athletics in the Administrative Procedures.

#### **Mandatory Regulatory Procedures**

Students attending home education programs shall be given an equal opportunity to compete for positions and participate in dDistrict extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs. Enrollment of eligible home education students in co-curricular activities shall be on a first come, first serve basis, dependent upon enrollment capacity.

A home education student may participate in extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs only at the school building the student would be assigned to if s/he was they were enrolled in the school dDistrict.

Prior to trying-out or joining an activity, a home education student shall submit required documents and written verification of eligibility to the building principal or designee.

To be considered in attendance in accordance with SRC policy, the home education student must participate in a full, normally scheduled academic program, in accordance with the planned home education program and submitted documentation.[2][6]

## **Delegation of Responsibility**

The building principal or designee shall ensure that home education students have access to information regarding the district's extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs.

The building principal or designee shall receive and review verification from the parent/guardian that a student has met and continues to meet the established eligibility criteria for an extracurricular activity or interscholastic athletic program.

The building principal or designee shall distribute information regarding eligibility criteria and student participation in extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletics to all affected by them.
